Definitions & Terms & Conditions



Definitions

The Event: Means the London Scavenger Hunt 2012 being the event described in more detail in the Information Sheet supplied to each Scout Leader and available on request from ShelterBox

Member: Means each individual who is named on a Team Registration Form and includes the Scout Leader

Scout Leader: Means each individual who is named as the scout leader and has signed the Team Registration Form

ShelterBox: Means ShelterBox Trust incorporated and registered in England and Wales with Company number 04612652 (and Charity number 1096479) whose registered office is at Water Ma Trout, Helston, Cornwall, TR13 0LW

Team Registration Form: Means the team entry form for the Event which is available on request from ShelterBox

Terms & conditions

Confirmation: The Event is only available to Teams with a maximum of 6 members per team including the Scout Leader. Upon receipt of a completed Team Registration Form ShelterBox will confirm acceptance of the Team's entry into the Event by post or email and this contract will only take effect on such confirmation of acceptance

Equipment and Materials: The Scout Leader will procure that his team will take reasonable care of and prevent damage to all equipment and materials supplied to the Members for the purpose of the Event. Participation in the Event will not confer any rights whatsoever in respect of the equipment and materials. Materials may not be copied, reproduced, republished, downloaded, posted, broadcast or transmitted in any way except for a Member's personal use

It is agreed and acknowledged that the intellectual property rights in any photographs, video footage or other materials taken by ShelterBox during the course of the Event vest in ShelterBox. ShelterBox shall determine in its absolute discretion how to use these materials

Health and Safety: The Scout Leader will procure that all members attend a mandatory pre-event safety briefing to be conducted by a ShelterBox Representative and observe the rules and guidelines set out in that briefing throughout the Event

The Scout Leader will immediately report to ShelterBox any accident or injury occurring during the Event

Limitation of Liability: ShelterBox does not accept any liability whatsoever, except for those matters for which it would be illegal or unlawful to exclude or attempt to exclude

Events outside ShelterBox's control: ShelterBox will not be liable or responsible for any failure to perform or delay in performance of any of its obligations under these terms and conditions

Rights of Third Parties: This contract does not create or confer any rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 which are enforceable by any person who is not a party to the Contract

Miscellaneous: Teams must return to Westminster City School no later than 16:00

All Cub and Scout teams must be accompanied by at least one Scout Leader throughout the Event. For Explorers if one member of the Team is over the age of 16 then the Scout Leader shall have the discretion to determine whether the Team needs to include a Scout Leader

ShelterBox may award prizes to Members. These prizes are not transferable and there will be no cash alternatives

ShelterBox reserves the right to alter the event or published schedule at any time

Nothing in these terms and conditions is intended to or shall be deemed to establish any partnership or joint venture between the parties constitute either party as the agent of the other party nor authorise either of the parties to make or enter into any commitments for or on behalf of the other party

These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Any dispute arising in connection with these terms and conditions will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts
